

Sample size and coverage	1639 respondents nationally, representative of the total population, with a boosted sample in Attica (350), Epirus (298), Central Macedonia (305), and Crete (300)
Data collection period	22 – 30 November 2022
Sampling	Multistage sampling using quotas with respect to geographical distribution, gender, and age of the population based on the 2011 census of the Hellenic Statistical Authority (ELSTAT). Data are weighted by gender, age, region and the 2019 national election results (raking)
Data collection method	Data collection implemented as follows: 72% (1178 interviews) via telephone interviews (CATI) and 28% (461 interviews) through a digital questionnaire (CAWI) addressed to members of Kapa Research inhouse online panel.
Error and rounding	Standard error of 3% with a confidence interval of 95%. Results (%) are rounded to 1% and <u>answers may not add up to 100%</u>
























